- Complete an online course through OCVS/FLVS
- At least a 2.0 unweighted GPA (C Average)
- Earn a **passing score** on the 10th grade FAST ELA & BEST Writing
  - OR 480 SAT EBRW
  - OR 18 ACT English & Reading Average
- Earn a **passing score** on the B.E.S.T/ Algebra I EOC Exam
  - OR 430 PSAT NMSQT Math
  - OR 420 SAT Math
  - OR 16 ACT Math
  - OR Level 3 Geometry EOC
- Take the Geometry, Biology, and US History EOC
  - Counts as 30% of Final Grade
