- Take the Geometry, Biology, and US History EOC Counts as 30% of Final Grade

- You cannot sign up for a course you have already taken (includes PE)
- Late Arrival / Early Release is granted to students who:
 - Have at least 19 of the required credits to have a period(s) off
 - Have at least a 2.5 unweighted cumulative GPA prior to Senior Year
 - Achieved an Accelerated Point (Passed an AICE, AP, Industry exam or passed a DE class)
 - Have passed the FSA ELA (or achieved a concordant score)
 - Have passed the Algebra 1 EOC (or achieved a concordant score)
 - Have met the above reqs & completed the <u>Early Release/Late Arrival Form</u>


