GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least a 2.0 unweighted GPA (C Average)
- Earn a **passing score** on the 10th grade FAST ELA
 - OR 480 SAT EBRW
 - OR 18 ACT English & Reading Average
- Earn a **passing score** on the Algebra 1/ BEST Math
 - OR 430 PSAT NMSQT Math
 - OR 420 SAT Math
 - OR 16 ACT Math
 - OR Level 3 Geometry EOC
- Take the Geometry, Biology, and US History EOC
 - Counts as 30% of Final Grade
- Complete an online course through OCVS/FLVS
